### **MedAssist Program**

#### Immediate Medication Assistance

1. If you qualify for assistance and funds are available, we may be able to assist with your immediate medication costs/co-pays, depending on the situation.
2. While casework is handled on a walk-in basis, appointments are encouraged.
3. We do not pay for: doctor/dentist visits (past, present or future), medical/dental bills, transportation costs to visit the doctor/dentist, medical equipment, air conditioners, fans or space heaters.
4. You will need to bring the following items with you when requesting assistance:
  - a. Photo I.D.
  - b. Proof of household income. One of the following can be used: most recent tax return, check stubs, most recent bank statement, Social Security awards letter. You must be at or below 185% of the Federal Poverty Level to be eligible.
  - c. Proof of current insurance (medical/prescription) or Medicaid.
  - d. Medication list with dosage and how often the medication is taken per day.
5. We cannot guarantee all medications. Most chronic medications and antibiotics are covered. Drugs not covered include, but are not limited to, those with street value, controlled medications and most pain medications.
6. Each client that qualifies could receive a total of up to \$250.00 per household per 12 month period.
